

Candidature for a membership in the ENCR Steering Committee

Mandate

The candidate should be prepared to actively participate in ENCR activities in cooperation with other members of the Steering Committee.

The non-exhaustive list of activities includes:

- participating in two to four annual meetings;
- addressing issues to registration practice;
- advising on the direction of ENCR;
- assisting in organization of scientific meetings and workshops;
- commenting and approving documents originating from ENCR activities;
- participating in working groups;
- representing ENCR;
- contributing to EUROCOURSE and other ENCR projects.

The prospective candidates are advised to refer to the Terms of reference of ENCR Steering Committee distributed with these instructions and available on the ENCR web-site <http://www.enchr.com.fr/>

The duration of the mandate is 3 years, with the possibility of re-election once.

Eligibility criteria

A candidate must be currently working in a population-based cancer registry which is a member of ENCR. Candidates must be supported by the director of their affiliated cancer registry and two other ENCR members (please see the attached candidature form). At least one signatory should be a ENCR member in another country.

A candidate must submit the attached candidature form complete with all requested information and signatures. Electronic signatures are accepted as long as the signatories are in the copy of the e-mail submitting the form.

A member of the current ENCR Steering Committee may be candidate for re-election, provided that the time of continuous service will not reach or exceed 6 years at the time of the next meeting of the ENCR Steering Committee.

A former member of the ENCR Steering Committee may be a candidate, provided that at least 3 years elapsed since the end of the past office.

The candidatures received after the deadline shown on the candidature form will be disregarded.

The elections

Once all candidatures are received, a list of all candidates will be prepared and all ENCR members will be asked to vote for a single candidate. The CV and the photo will be provided to the voters. The candidate with the highest score will become a new member of the ENCR Steering committee.
